

Victor Auffray

Victor started music when he was six with the guitar. In 2006 he started learning to play the euphonium and in 2011 he obtained his Diplôme d'études musicales (Diploma of musical studies) from

the Regional Conservatoire in Tours, having studied under Stéphane Balzeau. In 2017 he graduated from the Conservatoire national supérieur de musique et de danse (CNSMD) in Lyon, where his tutors were Stéphane Labeyrie and Arnaud Boukhitine. Between 2014 and 2018 he also studied jazz under Pierre Baldy at the École Nationale de Musique, Danse et Art Dramatique (ENM) in Villeurbanne.

In 2011, Victor won the Tours Tuba Competition and the Luxembourg young European soloists competition, and in 2015 he won the Yamaha Foundation scholarships contest. He has also won a prize in the Tours International Tuba Competition (Jazz category) and the FNAPEC chamber music competition in Paris with the group N.U.B.U.

He has played with various national orchestras including the Orchestre de Paris, the Opéra de Lyon and the Orchestre National de Lyon. Victor is also a member of the following groups: Radio Kaizman, Octotrip and NUBU (Nahash Urban Brass Unit).
